### DUE DATE

All submissions are due to the school office on February 23rd by 9am. (No earlier)

### EVENT TIME

### THEME

*"Inspired by the Bible"* Included with each submission should be a written title or description of the Bible Scripture or Bible story that the lego build is inspired by.

### COST

There is a \$3 contest entry fee. Upon entering, you will receive an official 10x10 lego baseplate and a copy of the contest rules. Baseplates can be picked up from the school office, as early as Monday, February 13th.

## RULES

1. Entries must be the student's own creation, not from a LEGO design kit, online template, or book.
2. The build should be constructed by the student, with minimal (10%) to no help.
3. All builds must fit on the official 10x10 baseplate provided by the school.
4. One entry per student.
5. Included with each submission should be a written title or description of the Bible Scripture or Bible story that the lego build is inspired by.
6. Entries must be submitted by Thursday, February 23rd by 9am.
7. Entries must be taken home on Monday, February 27th.
8. 3rd-6th Grade entries must include a moving element. Moving elements can include, but not be limited to, elements that spin, swing, rotate, bend, launch, etc.
